Creating Eneration is an opportunity to greatly expand what Bellin and Gundersen has already achieved with intentional sustainability investment: 80% emission reduction, approximately \$5 million in annual energy cost savings, and unmatched (in healthcare) renewable energy and sustainability infrastructure and expertise.

Eneration has bold goals over the next 10 years:

- Reduce energy demand in U.S. healthcare by 75 trillion Btu energy usage (Example: 75 trillion Btus represents a 10% reduction in the U.S. healthcare energy consumption.)
- Remove \$1 billion in expense from U.S. healthcare
- Eliminate 5 million tons of carbon dioxide generation in U.S. healthcare (Example: 5 million tons of CO2 would be equivalent to removing 1.1 million cars from U.S. roads)
